

This week's total figure for properties listed for sale is 1.36% lower than levels seen four weeks ago and is 27% lower than levels seen a year ago.



There were 5,496 properties for rent in Perth at the end of this week, which is 1.5% more than last week.

This week's rental listings figure is 1.38% lower than levels seen four weeks ago and is 19% lower than levels seen a year ago.
